Dear Mr. Vallance:

I wish to acknowledge your letter of foril 11, in which you express the desire of the Inter-American Bar Association to enter into a formal relationship with the Organization of American States.

In reply, I am happy to inform you that, pursuant to authorization given me by the Council of the Organization at its meeting of June 16, 1954, I am empowered to enter into general cooperative relations with worthwhile nongovernmental organizations, whose purposes are in harmony with those of the OAS. Such relations convey certain privileges to the Organization involved, namely those of receiving the publications of the Fan American Union, submitting its views in writing on matters of common interest, and participating in certain meetings of the Council and its organs, when invited to do so for the purpose of discussing a given topic. More detailed information regarding this type of relationship may be found in the attached pamphlet, and especially on pages 29 and 35 (paragraphs marked).

In view of the close cooperation that has long existed between the Inter-American Bar Association and the OAS, to which you have quite properly referred, it gives me great pleasure to take any step that will tend to strengthen that collaboration. Therefore, you may consider that the present letter completes the
