


American Oystercatcher Business Plan Model

Atlantic Flyway Shorebird Business Strategy, Phase 1



Goal: ↑ focal shorebird

- pops. 10-15% by 2020 Endorsement:>60 agencies, NGOs, universities
- Action-oriented: projects, funding, partners
- Flyway Scale but lacks true flyway engagement
