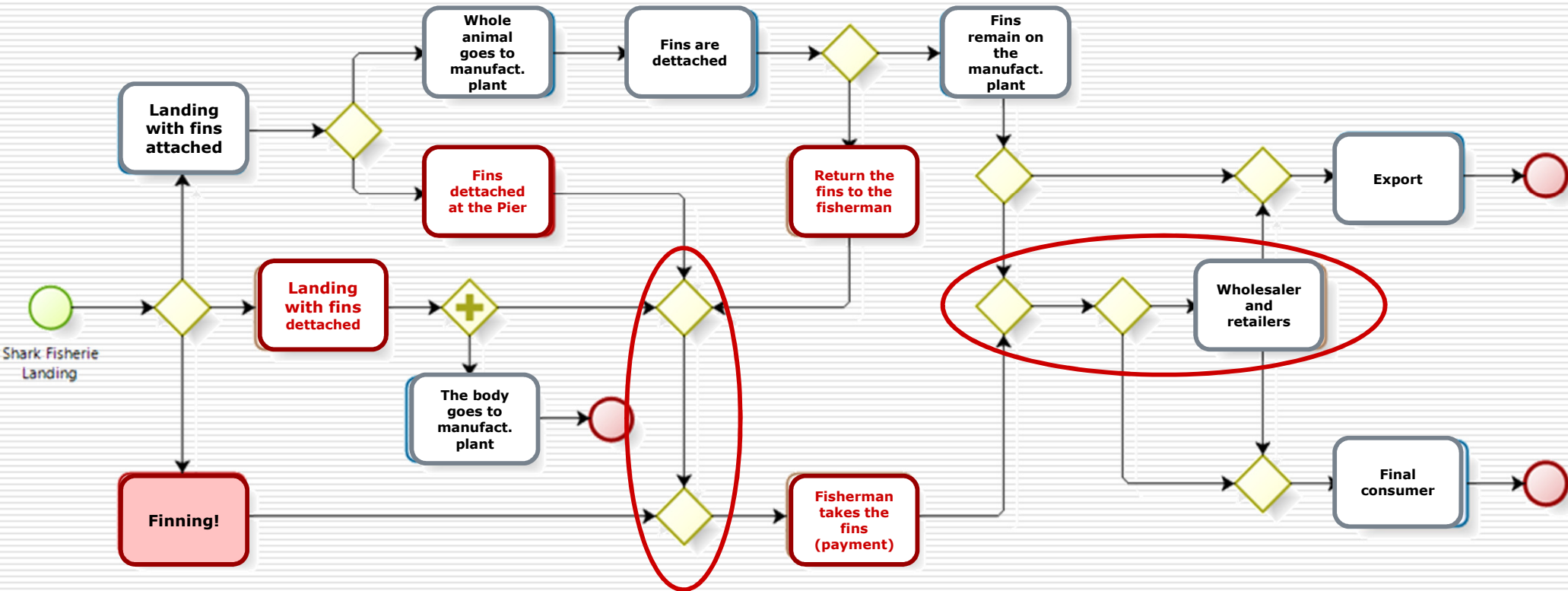
# Introduction

---

- “FISH DOCUMENT OF ORIGIN” (DOP) – What is it?
  - An electronic system to prevent or avoid environmental violations at the fishery custody chains, through the monitoring and tracking of production and commerce.
  
- Currently there isn't an efficient control system of the trade of fisheries resources;
  - For the majority of products, the only document is the invoice
  - Once at the custody chain, the control may become more and more complex

# Scope

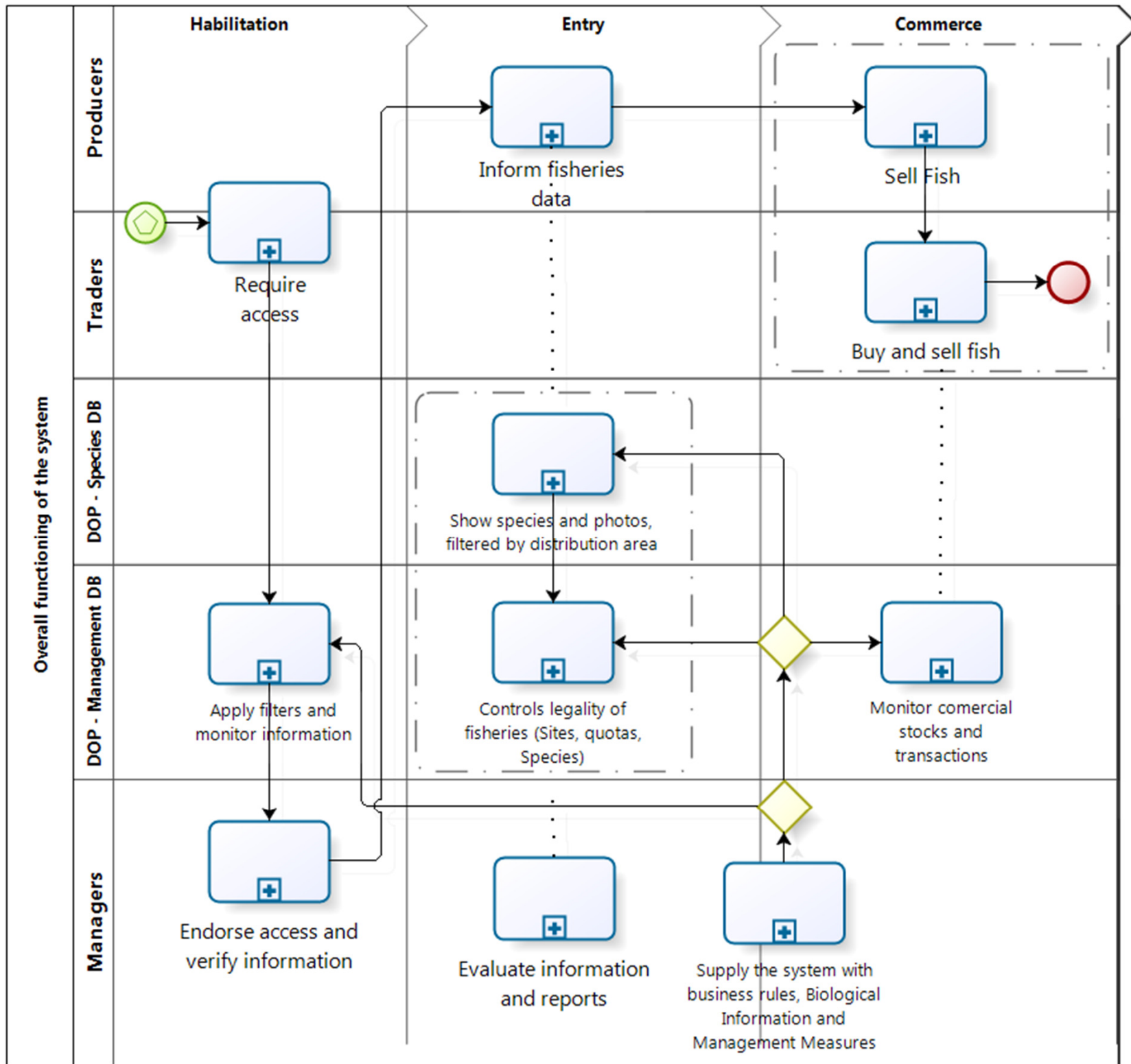

- General objective: To control and to monitor the captures and commerce of fish
  - To track on real time the production;
  - To reduce costs and optimize enforcement;
  
- What will the system control?
  - The transfer of fish, dead or alive, from the **producer or importer** to the **retailer or exporter**;
  - All transport with commercial purposes on Brazilian territory, **except from fishing grounds to landing sites**;

# Scope

---

- The system should be able to:
  - To issue Origin Certificates and Transport licences;
  - To monitor users deadlines and pendencies;
  - To control and monitor informations about fisheries, imports and aquaculture production;
  - To monitor fish stocks on the commerce;
  - To adapt to changes on fisheries regulation.
