

CHARLESTOWN Nevis, February 25th, 2013 -- The Nevis Disaster Management Department in collaboration with Hope Nevis Inc. has embarked upon a project entitled "Sustainable Communities". This initiative is an OAS Sponsored Project that is scheduled to be rolled out in ALL five parishes on Nevis commencing on Monday March 11th2013.

This project is being spearheaded by the non-governmental organization (NGO) HOPE NEVIS Inc. in collaboration with the Nevis Disaster Management Department and the Physical Planning, Natural Resources and Environment Offices.

- Emergency Shelter Management

- The Dangers of Sand Mining
- Gender Issues

The project will commence in the parish of St. Thomas and continue through to the other parishes. In this regard, the NDMD is seeking assistance in conveying the above details to the general public via your media. Subsequent releases will become available as the project moves island wide. We thank you for your cooperation as we endeavour to partner with you in keeping our fellow citizens informed and safe.
