EXPERTS BEFORE THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ELIMINATION OF ALL FORMS OF DISCRIMINATION AGAINST PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

In accordance with Article 2 of the Rules of Procedure of the Committee *for the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Persons with Disabilities* (CEDDIS), the Committee will be composed of a representative and two alternates designated by each State Party to the Convention. Their appointment shall remain in force until the appointing State decides otherwise.

To maintain a proper record of the members of the Committee and their respective alternates, States Parties must communicate, by means of notification addressed to the Technical Secretariat of CEDDIS <u>and through their Permanent Missions</u> to the Organization of American States (OAS), the name, personal data and contact information of their national experts as soon as they are appointed.

Similarly, Article 2 of the Rules of Procedure stipulates that each State Party shall immediately notify the OAS General Secretariat of any change in the designation of their experts to the Committee.

By virtue of the foregoing, the following list shall confirm as members of the Committee those representatives originally designated who, whether or not they have attended the last meetings convened by the Committee, have not been formally replaced by official communication from the Permanent Mission of their State to the OAS addressed to the Technical Secretariat. Therefore, their appointment is presumed to remain valid.

This list has taken as a reference the countries in the region that have ratified (not just signed) the Inter-American Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Persons with Disabilities (CIADDIS), or have acceded to it.

¹<u>Rule 4 of the Committee's rules of procedure</u>

The Committee shall elect a Chairman and two Vice-Presidents, taking into account the principles of gender equity and geographic representation. The President and Vice Presidents shall serve for a period of two years and may not be reelected for one additional term. In case of absence or temporary disability of the President, First Vice President shall replace him or her. In case of absence or permanent disability of the President and/or Vice Presidents, the Committee will elect new officers, as appropriate, to hold those positions.

² <u>Rule 2 of the Committee's rules of procedure</u>

The Committee shall comprise one representative and two alternates appointed by each state party to the Convention and shall remain in force until the designating State decides otherwise.

The members of the Committee shall be persons of high moral authority and shall have sound technical knowledge and experience in the different topics covered by the Convention, including knowledge of human rights, disability issues and public policy.

In the absence of the principal representative, alternates shall enjoy the same privileges.

The States Parties shall promote in the appointment of their representatives, primarily, the participation of people with disabilities, pursuant to Article V of the Convention, and their families, as well as the designation of at least one representative of civil society.

The states parties shall provide the OAS General Secretariat with the names and personal data of their representatives, such as their postal and e-mail addresses and their telephone and fax numbers, as soon as they have been appointed. Each state party shall notify the OAS General Secretariat immediately of any change in the appointment of its representative on the Committee.
