## IABIN Executive Committee/Coordinating Institution Meeting Tierras Enamoradas Costa Rica February 16-18, 2011

### Background and Goals:

The IABIN/GEF Project “Building the Inter-American Biodiversity Information Network” that provides basic financing for IABIN activities will complete operations in June 2011. Following a one year extension of the project granted by the GEF, planned project activities and disbursements are on track to be successfully completed by this date.

This IEC/CI meeting, the last with planned funding in the Project, will serve as a capstone to the broader IABIN project and examine the progress, challenges, lessons learned and current status of the network after six years of project implementation. Participants will briefly review completed activities, including Component 1: Interoperability and Access to Data, Component 2: Data Content Creation, and Component 3: Tools for Decision Making. IEC members and CIs will strategize how to best utilize and plan future development of the tools and products of the project, undergo brief training in the use of Component 3 tools, and continue the ongoing discussion on IABIN’s sustainability and future.

### Specific Goals for the meeting:

- IEC, CI members trained on Component 3 tools, able to promote them as needed in their countries, international meetings, etc.
- IEC feedback on final development of IABIN
- CI coordination on fundraising
- Ensuring linkages with global, national level sister initiatives
- Celebrating successes and learning from failures in IABIN
