Trends

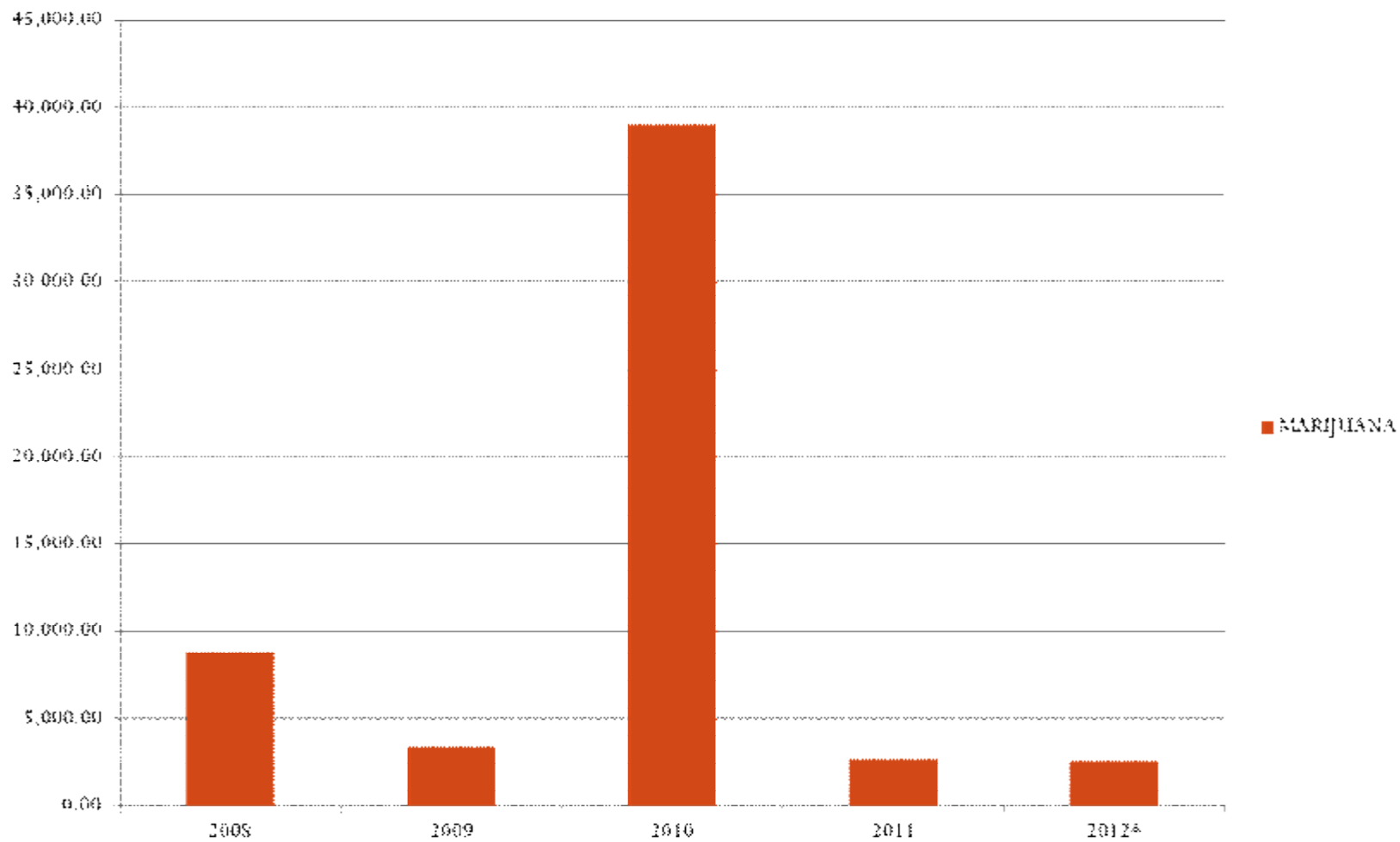
- **Significant Seizures of Narcotics- including swallowers of marijuana**
