- ⁽³⁾ As used here *substantial* could refer to whatever obstacle materially impeded the implementation. It refers to whatever the country believes constituted this condition, whether or not the recommendation is reported as completely implemented.
- ⁽⁴⁾ This is provided so that countries, where national resources are inadequate, can specify what assistance may be needed: technical or material.
- ⁽⁵⁾ Beyond the information already provided, this area enables the responding country to include information of any kind which it considers essential to understanding the response to the recommendation.
