- To obtain, analyze and disseminate objective, reliable and comparable information on drugs and drug addiction, and their consequences, in order to provide a evidence-based description of the drug phenomenon at the European level.
- This information is aimed at politicians, scientists and researchers responsible for responding to the problem, and the public in general.

#### The EMCDDA

- Central reference point on drug information in the European Union
- Established in 1/993, situated in Lisbon, Portugal
- Decentralized Agency of the EU
  - Agencies respond to the decentralization, and to the new technical or scientific tasks
  - Other crucial agencies for the protection of public health:
    - The European Medicines Agency, United Kingdom;
    - European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control, Sweden.



### Focus from the Perspective of Obtaining Data

- Obtaining Data
  - National Information Points and expert groups in each member state (REITOX), prepare national reports for the EMCDDA;
  - Contact with other data collection specialists;
  - Technical Work Groups.
- Methods
  - Annual expert group meetings;
  - Ad hoc work groups more reduced for the development of indicators;
  - Emphasis to favor adopting common methods;
  - Emphasis on offering additional value at the European level.

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### FIVE KEY INDICATORS

- 1. Use of drugs, behaviour, and attitudes of the general population (statistical)
- 2. Estimates of the prevalence of drug consumption.
- 3. Requests for/treatment by drug consumers.
- 4. Drug-related deaths, mortality and its causes among drug users.
- 5. Extent of/infectious diseases related to drugs.
