

Factors fostering drug trafficking in Venezuela





STRUCTURE AND PRINCIPAL PLAYERS IN DRUG TRAFFICKING IN VENEZUELA






SOME CAUSES OF THE DRUG SUB-CULTURE/ DRUG USE AND PARTICIPATION IN MICRO-TRAFFICKING







ELIMINATION OF POLICIES IN FAVOR OF PROVIDING TREATMENT FOR DRUG USERS

- Article 11 OF THE ORGANIC LAW ON DRUGS: Public system for addiction care and treatment.
- Article 12 OF THE ORGANIC LAW ON DRUGS: Provide education and training for work, granting top priority to social plans, programs, and projects.
- Article 141 OF THE LAW ON DRUGS: Procedure in drug use cases. Anyone found consuming narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances, or who describes himself or herself as a drug user, or who is in possession of such substances in amounts not higher than the dose shall be required to undergo screening for drugs in urine, blood, or other body fluids. In addition, the substance seized shall be subject to chemical and/or botanical tests.



CONSEQUENCES OF ELIMINATING CERTAIN POLICIES IN FAVOR OF TREATING USERS:

 WITHOUT THESE MECHANISMS, A PERSON CAPTURED WITH DRUGS ENDS UP BEING TAKEN FOR A MICRO-TRAFFICKER IN THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM.

Key to Slide 8: WHY DID YOU DECIDE TO COME TO COLOMBIA? It was the least costly place to emigrate to. Job opportunities. I had family or friends there to help me get settled. It offers plenty of opportunities for Venezuelans. Because I possess Colombian nationality. It was the closest country. Other reasons. Don't know/Don't remember.

WHY DID YOU DECIDE TO LEAVE VENEZUELA? Food shortages. Need to earn more income. Insecurity in Venezuela. High cost of goods and services. No education or future for my children. High cost of housing. To study. Direct

threats to my life or that of family members.
