Large Degree of Diversity

POPULATION

- Less than 100 thousand inhabitants
- More than 100 million inhabitants

WEALTH (Per capita GDP)

- Above US\$35 thousand
- Below US\$4 thousand

HUMAN DEVELOPMENT INDEX

- Above 0.95
- Below 0.7

INEQUALITY (GINI INDEX, %)

- Above 55 (poor distribution)
- Below 46 (moderate distribution)

LARGE DEGREE OF DIVERSITY

- DIFFERENCES ACROSS COUNTRIES
 - By drug
- -WITHIN COUNTRIES
 - By drug

Marijuana

- Most consumed illicit drug worldwide.
- 143-190* million people (15 to 64 years) consumed during the past year (3.3%-4.4%).
- Difficult to establish production of the drug with precision.
- Cultivated in more than 170 countries













Admission to Treatment Centers

Steady Increase in Treatment Admissions with Marijuana as the Primary Substance of Abuse Since 1994



Emergency Room Admissions Organization of American States

Emergency department episodes involving marijuana almost tripled from 1994 to 2002. Marijuana steadily increased over that decade, surpassing heroin — which remained relatively flat — in 1998.



- **WORLD**: 16 to 20 million persons (at least once during the past year)
 - PAST YEAR PREVALENCE =0,4% 0,5%

- **EUROPE**: 4.3 to 4.6 million. **Approx=25%**
 - PAST YEAR PREVALENCE = 0.8% (0.1%-3%)

- AMERICA: 9.4 to 9.6 million. APROX=53%
 - PAST YEAR PREVALENCE = 1.6% (0.1%-2.8%)




AMONG THE TOTAL COCAINE USERS IN THE HEMISPHERE

- 75% in North America
- 24% in South America
- 1% in Central America and the Caribbean




 Also, high levels of use at the secondary school (high school) level

 Past Year Prevalence above 3% in the United States, Canada and Uruguay.










Cocaine: Signs of Dependence American States

VARIABILITY WITHIN COUNTRIES

COCAINE

- United States: 1.7%-3.4% (2004-2005)
- Colombia: 0.1%-2.1% (2008)
- Chile: 0.1%-2.3% (2006)

MARIJUANA

- United States: 8%-16.3%
- Colombia: 0.1%-5.3%
- Chile: 1.8%-8.5%



TRENDS

MARIJUANA:

- Increase in several countries, both at general population level as well as secondary school
- Stabilization of trend in others, mainly among countries with high levels of use

• COCAINE:


- Increase in several countries
- Stabilization and decrease in some countries

Canada: Ecstasy (MDMA) Adulteration States




□ only MDMA ■ MDMA and others □ MDMA and Ketamine ■ MDMA and meth □ MDMA and cocaine
