

**PCC.III/REC. 38 (X-98)<sup>1</sup>**

**REGULATORY ADJUSTMENT FOR INCREASING TELEDENSITY**

The Tenth Meeting of the Permanent Consultative Committee III: Radiocommunications,

**CONSIDERING:**

- a) Cellular systems are operating in the 800 MHz band throughout the region.
- b) PCS systems are being introduced in some countries in the region.
- c) Terminal equipment exists designed to offer fixed telephony services in cellular networks.
- d) Both cellular and PCS systems can offer a fixed service.

**RECOGNIZING:**

The need to increase teledensity in most of the countries in the region.

**TAKING INTO ACCOUNT:**

That there has been heavy investment in the cellular system infrastructure and that these systems have a wide coverage in the region.

**RECOMMENDS:**

To urge the member state administrations to study the possibility of evaluating, with basis on their policies, regulations, economy and communication requirements, the convenience of allowing the possibility of cellular and PCS to also offer fixed services.
