

PCC.III/REC. 13 (III-95)

800-900 MHz TRUNKING¹

The Third Meeting of Permanent Consultative Committee III: Radiocommunications

Considering:

That Trunking Services in the bands of 800-900 MHz for use by private and public services and public safety are becoming more and more prevalent in the Region; and

That harmonized band allocations and Type Approval Standards within the Region will facilitate cross border and sub-regional commerce; and

That non-harmonized allocations within the Region may preclude the realization of the benefits of Public Safety and trunked public and private services.

Recommends:

1. That the harmonization of the band allocations, trunking channel band plan and Type Approval Standards should be addressed by CITEL members with some urgency.

Instructs:

The Executive Secretary of CITEL to distribute this Recommendation as well as the information paper entitled "A Perspective on 800-900 MHz Trunking in the United States" to all PCC.III members, requesting that their comments be sent to the Chairman of the Working Group on Terrestrial Mobile Communications.
