SUBMITTAL OF THE CASE STUDY AND DEVELOPMENT OF STRATEGIES TO PROMOTE GROWTH OF LOCAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACCESS INFRASTRUCTURE IN THE STATE MEMBERS OF CITEL

The III Meeting of the Permanent Consultative Committee I: Telecommunication Standardization,

CONSIDERING:

- a) The urgent need of the countries in the region to increase the telephony density and the access of larger number of end users to telecommunication services;
- b) The reduction of investments in basic telecommunications infrastructure that has affected both the industry and the end users;
- c) That the III Assembly of CITEL asked the Consultative Committees to develop strategies to promote joint works and benefits of the Members States of CITEL and Associate Members;
- d) That the development of strategies to enable the growth of local telecommunication services will allow the attraction of a larger number of Associate Members to actively participate in the PCC.I Works, and,
- e) That current wireline and wireless technological solutions can support and solve the need for local telecommunication access growth,

RESOLVES:

- 1. To approve that activity be considered a priority within the new framework of the Permanent Consultative Committee I.
- 2. To direct the Chairs of the Working Groups of PCC.I to include recommendations in all their works and results so as to apply them when promoting the growth of Local Telecommunications Access to the countries in the Americas.
