**USE OF E-MAIL FOR THE TRANSMISSION OF OFFICIAL
COMMUNICATIONS TO MEMBERS,
PERMANENT MISSIONS AND ASSOCIATE MEMBERS**

The Second Regular Meeting of the Assembly of the Inter-American
Telecommunication Commission, CITEL,

CONSIDERING:

That the amount of work and cost involved in preparing and sending various
communications concerning the activities of CITEL has increased dramatically with the
growth of the number of Associate members; and

The advantages (convenience and speed) of electronic mail for distribution of
communications to large numbers of organizations;

RESOLVES:

That, being the telecommunications arm of the OAS, CITEL should be an example for
all in the utilization of modern means of telecommunications to distribute the
communications of CITEL.

INSTRUCTS:

That the Executive Secretary utilize the electronic mail capability whenever
possible, in place of facsimile and regular mail, to distribute the communications of CITEL.
