

## **CITEL RES. 67 (V-10) <sup>1</sup>**

### **PARTICIPATION BY OBSERVERS IN MEETINGS OF CITEL**

The Fifth Regular Meeting of the Assembly of the Inter-American Telecommunication Commission (CITEL),

#### **CONSIDERING:**

- a) Article 7 of the Statute and articles 14, 15, 16, 17 and 85 of CITEL Regulations referring to those organizations that may be represented by observers at CITEL meetings, and
- b) Resolution CITEL RES. 50 (IV-06), approved during the Fourth Regular Meeting of the Assembly of CITEL, that includes a list of entities and organizations invited to participate in CITEL meetings.

#### **BEARING IN MIND:**

- a) That, since then, the following organizations have signed up Cooperation Agreements with the General Secretariat of the OAS through and for the CITEL:

#### **RESOLVES:**

1. To authorize the CITEL Secretariat to invite the following entities and organizations that are directly involved in the telecommunications sector, to participate in CITEL meetings:

2. To repeal Resolution CITELE RES. 50 (IV-06).

To authorize COM/CITEL, *ad referendum* the decision of the next CITELE Assembly, to extend Observer status to all other entities and organizations that offer similar reciprocal observer privileges to CITELE by way of the pertinent Cooperation Agreements, and to authorize the CITELE Secretariat to invite them to all CITELE meetings.

4. To affirm that with respect to Observer participation in the Permanent Consultative Committees (PCCs), the CITELE Secretariat's authority to invite Observers pursuant to this Resolution is subject to the corresponding rules and regulations of each PCC.

**INSTRUCTS THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY:**

To prepare a table containing a summarized program of CITELE annual activities, showing in detail the date, place and purpose of the meetings, which will be forwarded to the other international organizations and/or entities in order to keep them informed on those activities and enable them to request their participation as observers through usual procedures.
