

RECOGNITION OF DR. CECILY HOLIDAY FOR HER LEADERSHIP TO CITEL

The 37th Meeting of Permanent Consultative Committee II: Radiocommunication (PCC.II),

DECIDES:

To instruct the Executive Secretary to send a letter of appreciation to Dr. Cecily Holiday of the Administration of the United States of America in recognition of her longstanding dedication and successful leadership in raising the profile and effectiveness of CITEL, with the consequent benefit for the entire Region of the Americas.

Dr. Holiday led efforts to create the Permanent Consultative Committee III Working Group on Preparations for World Radiocommunication Conferences and to develop Inter-American Proposals to ITU Conferences; she chaired the PCC.III Working Group on Preparation for the 1997 World Radiocommunication Conference; and she spurred CITEL's efforts to advocate for representatives of CITEL Member States, including female candidates, to serve in ITU elected offices and as chairs of ITU Conferences and other groups.

Dr. Holiday sought to strengthen CITEL's future through efforts to promote the participation of the widest range of CITEL Member States in leadership roles within the PCC.II WRC Working Group and as CITEL spokespersons at ITU Conferences and meetings.
