

**CREATION OF CORRESPONDENCE GROUP TO REVIEW THE TEXT OF THE  
RECOMMENDATION ON EFFORTS AGAINST CYBERCRIME AND PIRACY OF  
TELEVISION CONTENT AND SIGNALS IN LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN**

The 38 Meeting of Permanent Consultative Committee I: Telecommunications/Information and Communication Technologies (PCC.I),

**DECIDES:**

1. To create a Correspondence Group to work electronically in between the 38 and 39 meetings of the PCC.I to review the Draft Recommendation on efforts against cybercrime and the piracy of television content and signals in Latin America and the Caribbean, contained in document CCP.I-TIC/doc. 5078/21.
2. To appoint Mrs. María José Franco ([mariajose.franco@miem.gub.uy](mailto:mariajose.franco@miem.gub.uy)) of the administration of Uruguay as coordinator of said group.
3. To invite CITEL Member States and Associate Members to submit their comments and contributions to the text of the Draft Recommendation on efforts against cybercrime and the piracy of television content and signals in Latin America and the Caribbean.
4. To invite CITEL Member States and Associate Members to join the Correspondence Group within the framework of the Rapporteurship on conformance, fraud and illegal or irregular mobile terminal devices control, making contributions on the subject of copyright, intellectual property, marketing of devices, or other related topics to exchange knowledge and coordinate strategies to combat the piracy of audiovisual content and television signals.
5. To instruct the administration of Uruguay and the Rapporteurship on conformance, fraud and illegal or irregular mobile terminal devices control, in coordination with the Secretariat of CITEL, to hold virtual meetings, if necessary, to discuss and reach consensus on the wording to be presented at the 39 Meeting of PCC.I
