

PCC.II/RES. 148 (XL-22)¹
TO SUPPRESS PROVISIONS OF PCC II THAT HAVE LOST VALIDITY

The 40th Meeting of Permanent Consultative Committee II: Radiocommunications (PCC.II),

CONSIDERING:

That Resolution PCC.II/RES. 142 (XXXIX-22) approved the “Procedure for Updating Databases Containing Information on PCC.II Approved Instruments”. At the same time, it was adopted the “Compendium of Resolutions, Decisions, and Recommendations of PCC.II”, updated until the 38th Meeting of PCC.II, pending the “Suggested actions on doubts and special cases detected during the review of PCC.II resolutions, decisions, and recommendations”

NOTING:

Article 85, paragraph 13 of the CITEL Rules of Procedure, which establishes that PCCs must periodically evaluate the need to maintain their Working Groups, Rapporteurs and Ad Hoc Groups, taking into consideration their activity and efficiency in the work.

That from the evaluation carried out the convenience emerge of suppressing those resolutions, decisions and recommendations that, due to the time and the topic into consideration in each case, have lost their validity

Resolution CITEL/RES.93 (VIII-22) on "Establishment of Standing Advisory Committees," which establishes the objective and mandates of CCP.II.

RESOLVES:

To suppress Decision PCC.II/DEC. 39 (VI-05) on “To instruct the Secretariat of CITEL to establish a Discussion Group on the topic of broadband power line (bpl) in the electronic forum of CITEL”.

To suppress Decision PCC.II/DEC. 41 (VI-05) on “To create a Sub-Working Group to develop proposals in order to provide solutions of harmful interference to satellite communications systems”.

To suppress Decision PCC.II/DEC.58 (XI-08) on “To create a Discussion Group in the electronic forum of CITEL named "IMT"

To suppress Decision PCC.II/DEC.74 (XII-08) on “To create a Discussion Group in the electronic forum of CITEL to follow the activities of the ITU dealing with emergency telecommunications”.

To suppress Decision PCC.II/DEC. 103 (XVI-10) on” Rapporteurs to ITU-R Working Parties and Study Group on satellite services”.

To record that the reference contained in Recommendation PCC.III/REC. 31 (VIII-97) on Recommendation PCC.III/REC. 22 (VI-96), does not apply.

To suppress Recommendation PCC.III/REC. 58 (XVI-00) on “Stratospheric stations in tropical regions”
