

PCC.II/RES. 157 (XLIII-24)¹

PARTICIPATION OF PCC.II IN THE NOW4WRC27 INITIATIVE

The 43 Meeting of Permanent Consultative Committee II: Radiocommunications (PCC.II),

CONSIDERING:

- a) that CITEI is committed to promoting gender equality;
- b) that Resolution ITU-R 72 relative to promoting gender equality and equity and bridging the contribution and participation gap between women and men in ITU Radiocommunication Sector activities, encourages regional organizations to support, to the extent practicable, gender balance by actively promoting the inclusion of women in all aspects of ITU-R activities, including domestic, regional and international processes;
- c) that the Network of Women for WRC-23 (NOW4WRC23) has been a forum for establishing networks, mentorships, and the exchange of knowledge;
- d) that the NOW4WRC27 initiative is aimed at promoting the targets, goals, and achievements obtained in the new period of ITU-R studies prior to the next World Radiocommunication Conference;
- e) that the ITU's structure for the initiative involves regional co-chairs; and
- f) that CITEI's co-chair for NOW4WRC23 acted as vice-chair of the PCC.II Mentorship Program and obtained excellent results in her work, because of which it is necessary to uphold and consolidate these efforts,

RESOLVES:

- 1. to designate Ms. Shelli Haskins (shaskins@ntia.gov), from United States as regional co-chair for the NOW4WRC27 initiative and vice-chair of the PCC.II Mentorship Program;
- 2. to designate Amalia Castro, (amalia.castro@ift.org.mx) from Mexico, Michelle Caldeira (michelle.caldeira@ses.com) from Brazil and Lina Zuluaga (lina.zuluaga@ane.gov.co) from Colombia as vicechairs of the gender PCC.II initiative;
- 3. to request the regional co-chair to report in due time on the activities and work carried out in the ITU;
- 4. to request the regional co-chair to conduct the activities and work needed to contribute to the achievement of the objectives of the initiative and program;
- 5. to invite CITEI members to participate actively with their contributions in the activities in connection with this work; and
- 6. to request the CITEI Secretariat to collaborate with the regional co-chair in the development of these activities.
