

PCC.III/RES. 49 (VII-97)

ACCESSION TO THE CONVENTION

ON AN INTERNATIONAL AMATEUR RADIO PERMIT (IARP)

The Seventh Meeting of the Permanent Consultative Committee III:
Radiocommunications,

CONSIDERING:

That the IARP Convention was adopted on 8 June 1995 at the General Assembly of the Organization of American States in Haiti;

That two countries, the United States of America and Uruguay, acceded to the Convention on that same date;

That Argentina, Canada, Peru, Venezuela, and Trinidad and Tobago have acceded subsequently,

RECOGNIZING:

That PCC.III/RES.13(III-95) resolved to urge the Member States of the OAS to consider becoming signatories to the IARP Convention and requested the Executive Secretary to bring the resolution to the attention of CITEL countries,

RESOLVES:

To urge the remaining Member States to consider accession to the IARP Convention.
