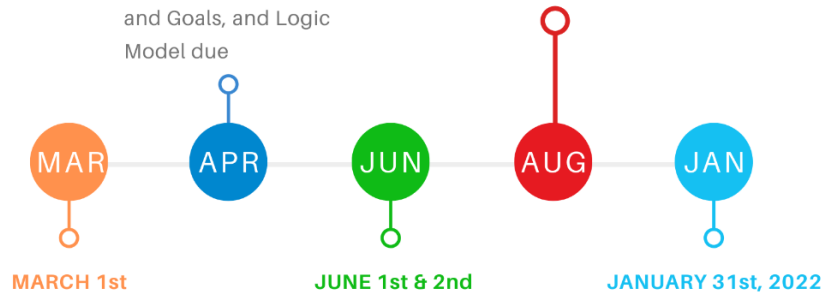

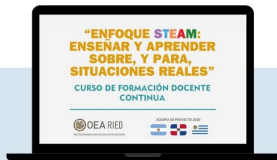

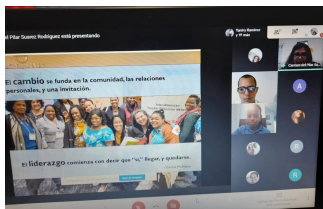
ITEN Project Team Work Recognized by the Teacher Task Force
