WHO

Can apply?

International students from **Latin America or the Caribbean** enrolled in their last two years of undergraduate or graduate programs at accredited universities in the United States.

HOW

Much can I receive?

Up to \$15,000 dollars in **interest-free** student loan(s) to be repaid in 50 installments, three months after completion of studies.

WHEN

Is the deadline to apply?

There are **no deadlines**. Applications are received and reviewed monthly throughout the year and at any time during your studies in the U.S.

WHAT

Is our Vision?

To invest in highly qualified individuals, capable of applying the benefit of their education for the development of their countries.
