

# Enacting a New Chemical Control Authority delegated to DEA





## Registration for handlers of List I chemicals

- Handlers include manufacturers, distributors, importers, and exporters
- Registration considerations:
  - Effective controls against diversion of listed chemicals?
  - Compliance with applicable Federal, State, and local law?
  - Prior convictions relating to controlled substances or listed chemicals?
  - Past experience in the manufacture and distribution of chemicals?
  - Other factors relevant to and consistent with the public health and safety.
- Separate registration for different groups of activities
- Separate registration for separate locations
- Registrations are renewed annually



# On site inspection required for every new List I chemical registration:

- Review of the completed DEA application to verify the information is complete and accurate.
- Obtain a description of the company's planned activity with the List I chemical(s).
- 3. Obtain information on the principals of the firm as well as those responsible for handling List I chemicals to include, but not limited to, date of birth, home address, and home phone number.
- 4. Review of State and Federal licenses and certificates.
- 5. Obtain supplier list and customer list.
- 6. Review of the firm's business practices and procedures including procedures for identifying suspicious orders of listed chemicals.
- Inspection of the firm's physical security and its procedures for employee screening/background checks.



# Requirements for handlers of List I chemicals


For manufacturers, distributors, importers, and exporters:

- Recordkeeping
- Reporting
- "Know Your Customer" Policy:
  - Must verify the identity of their customers and understand the normal and expected transactions typically conducted by those customers.
  - Detect and report suspicious transactions.
- Tools to address unauthorized activities involving listed chemicals:
  - Suspension or revocation of DEA registration
  - Violations may result in civil fines and criminal penalties

## 4-Anilinopiperidine (4-AP), its amides, its carbamates, and its salts





## **NFLIS-Drug**





**4-Piperidone**, its acetals, its amides, its carbamates, its salts, and salts of its acetals, its amides, and its carbamates






