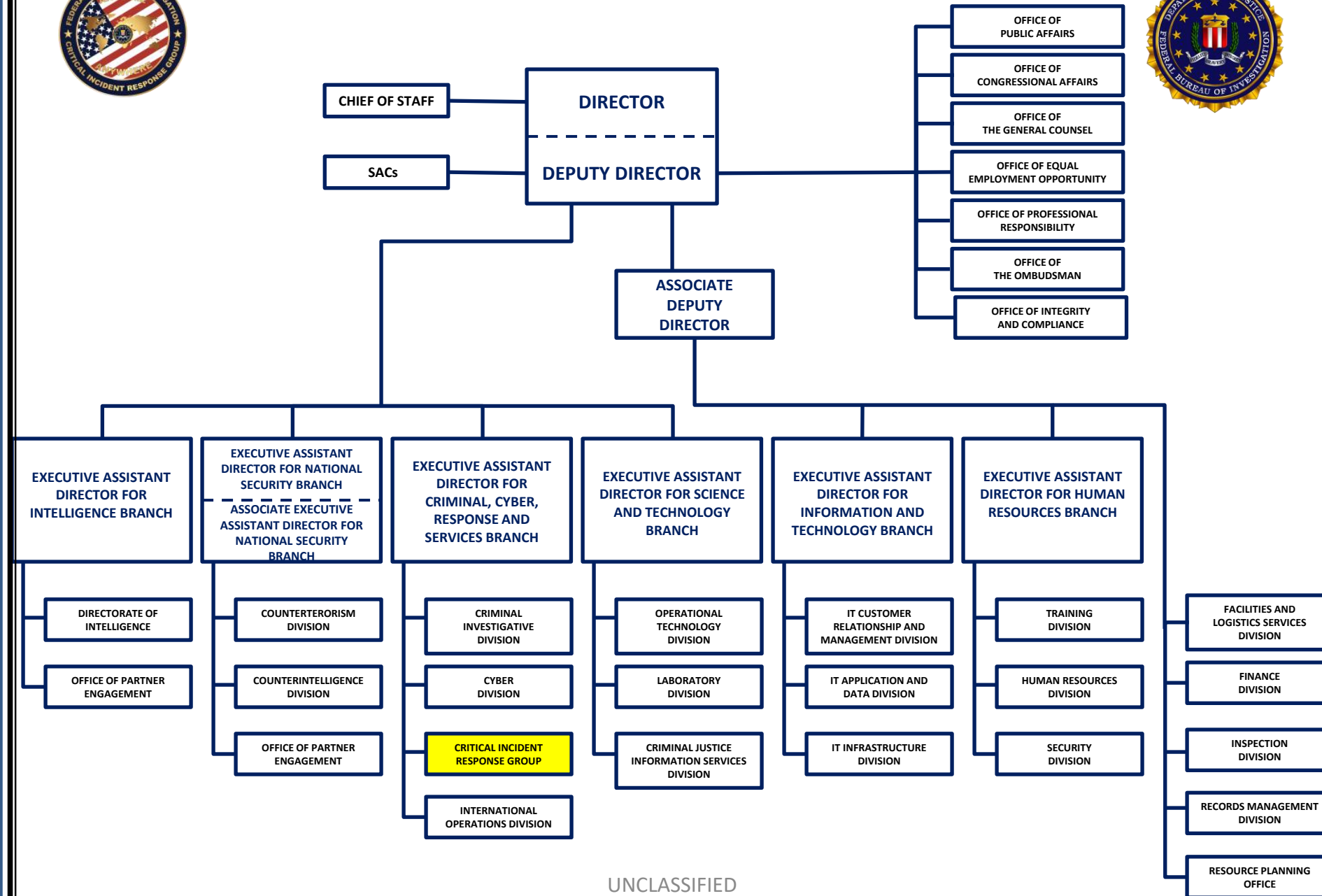

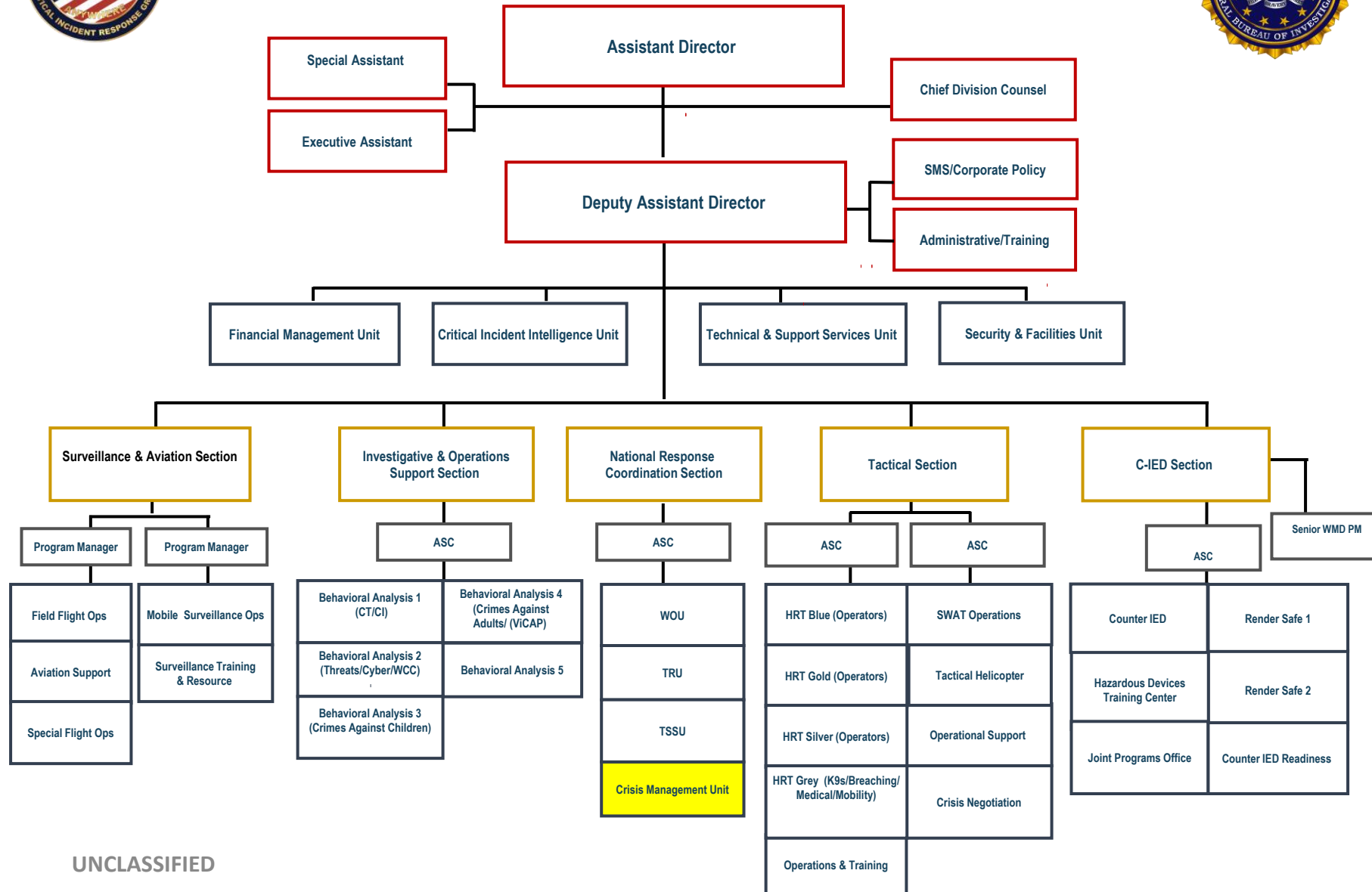

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# Critical Incident Response Group



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## Why is the FBI Involved:

### Presidential Policy Directive (PPD) – 25

- FBI is the lead federal agency for **investigating threats or acts of terrorism** directed against US citizens or US interests both domestically AND internationally (includes WMD).

### PPD – 22

- In designated National Special Security Events (NSSEs), the FBI has the lead responsibility for **domestic intelligence and counterterrorism** and investigations of Federal Crimes that are within its statutory jurisdiction.

### PPD – 8

- FBI is the lead for **counterterrorism and counterintelligence** investigations and related law enforcement activities across the critical infrastructure sectors.

### Executive Order 12333

- FBI is lead for **domestic intelligence collection and counterintelligence** activities.

### Executive Order 12656

- National security **emergency preparedness**



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## Definition of a special event:

A significant domestic or international event, occurrence, circumstance, contest, activity, or meeting which, by virtue of its profile and of/or status, **represents an attractive target for acts of terrorism.**

Formally designated as:

Special Event Assessment Rating (**SEAR**) 1 - 5

National Special Security Event (**NSSE**)

International Special Security Event (**ISSE**)



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## FBI Role and Responsibilities:

### Domestic

- Required to plan, coordinate, develop, or provide FBI resources
- To mitigate potential threats the special event may cause to national security or threats of significant criminal activity
- Identifying, **preventing**, investigating, or disrupting terrorist attacks

### International

- Support the USG, LEGAT and host nation operations by deploying FBI SMEs and crisis management personnel to assist with the response to threats and critical incidents aimed at or involving US Citizens
