ICC T20 Cricket World Cup

Support Period : 25th – 31st May 2024

Match Period : 12th – 26th June 2024





OBJECTIVE

Fifty-five matches will be played across nine cities – three in the U.S. and six in the Caribbean, with the opening match between Canada and the U.S. to be held on June 1 in Dallas, and the grand finale on June 29 in Barbados. The semi-final No.1 will take place in **Trinidad and Tobago** on the June 26.

New York City will host the much-anticipated clash between Pakistan and India on June 9, according to the schedule released.

Operations in Trinidad & Tobago – Mission 1-3

1. **Trophy Tour** – Trinidad would be hosting the Tour of the Trophy on the May 18 at BLCA.
2. **Support Period** – Practice and Warm Up Matches are scheduled for the period May 25 – 31, involving Nine (9) Teams at Four (4) Venues
3. **Matches** – Five (5) matches would be held at **Brian Lara Cricket Academy**, Toruba, starting from 12th June, 2024 [West Indies vs New Zealand]. Trinidad and Tobago will also host Semi-Final No.1, at Brian Lara Cricket Academy on June 26.



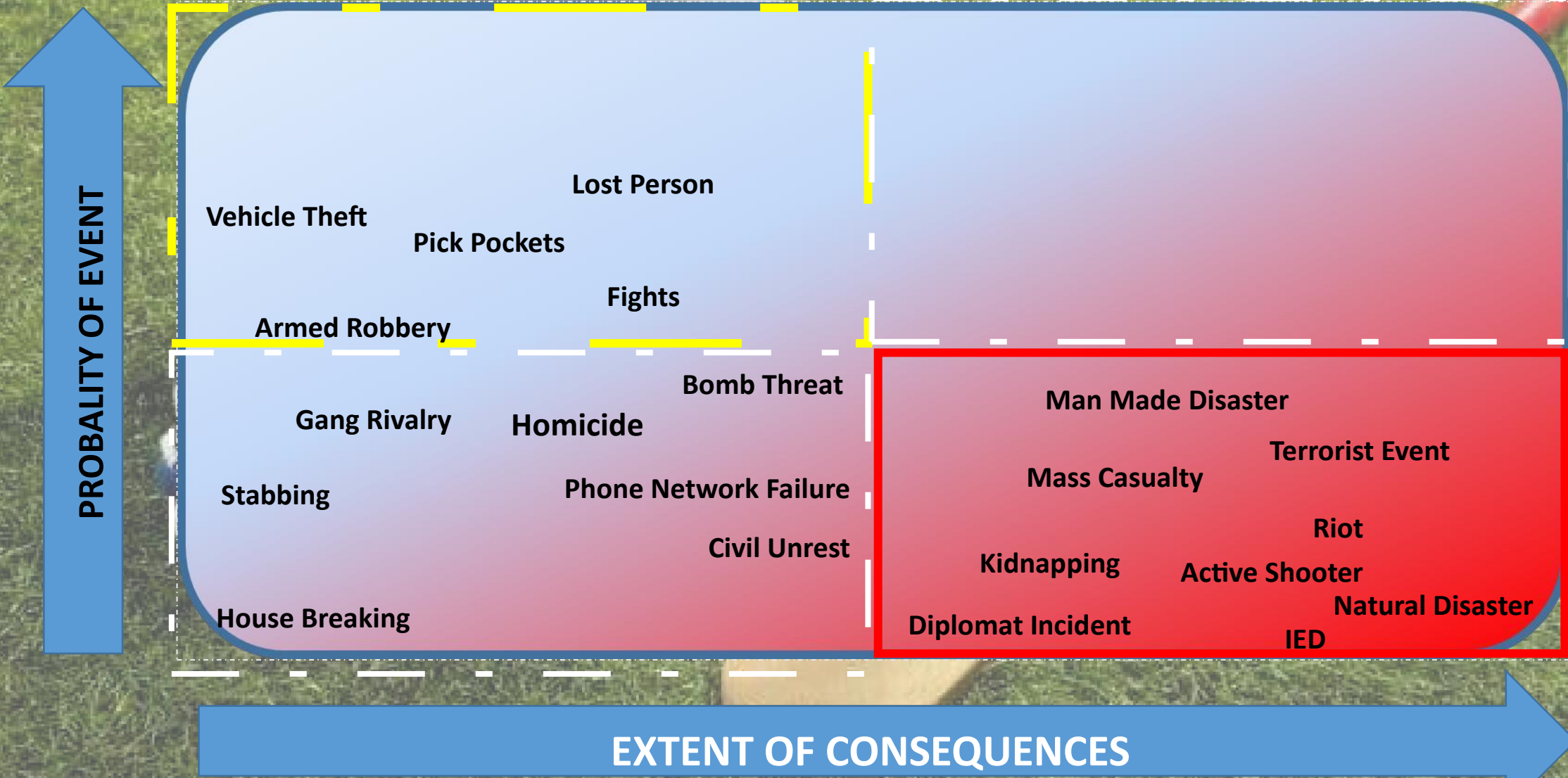

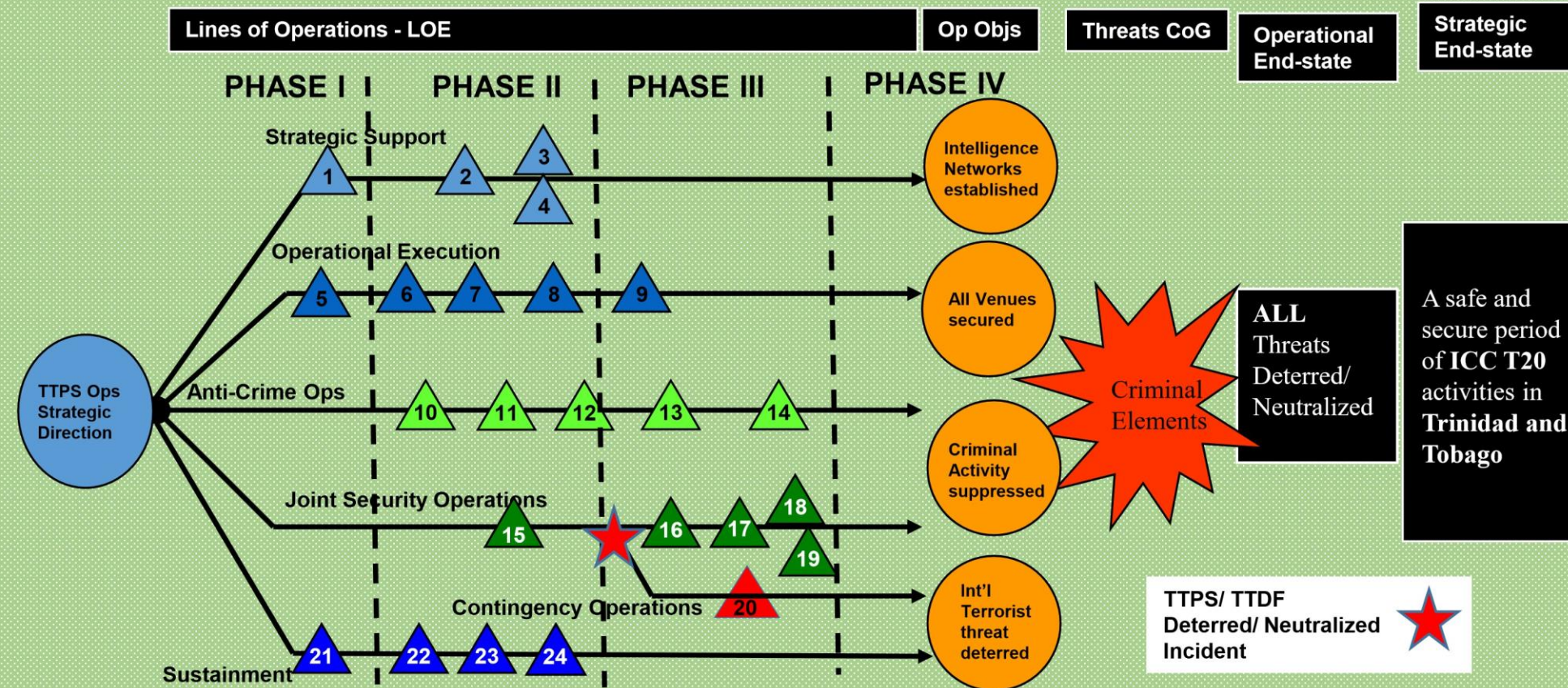

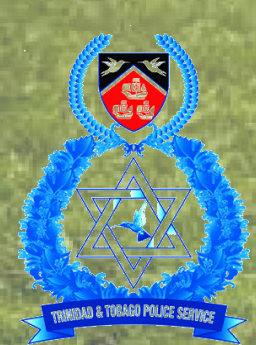

Mission Analysis – Venue Layout

- The Brian Lara Cricket Academy (BLCA) is a state-of-the-art competition venue and training facility for the development of world-class cricketers.
- The North Tower houses the Writing Press, Broadcast and Operations Floors.
- The Main Level contains facilities for concessions; rental spaces for the sale of refreshments and novelties, and washrooms.
- The South Stand is comprised of the Club Level which houses a restaurant space, lounge area and 3 conference rooms; while the Suite Level has 18 individual suites which are to be furnished by the end users.
- Total Capacity Seating for **18,000+ Persons**, 72 meters radius or 16,288 square meters playing field encompassing 6 pitches on the playing field.



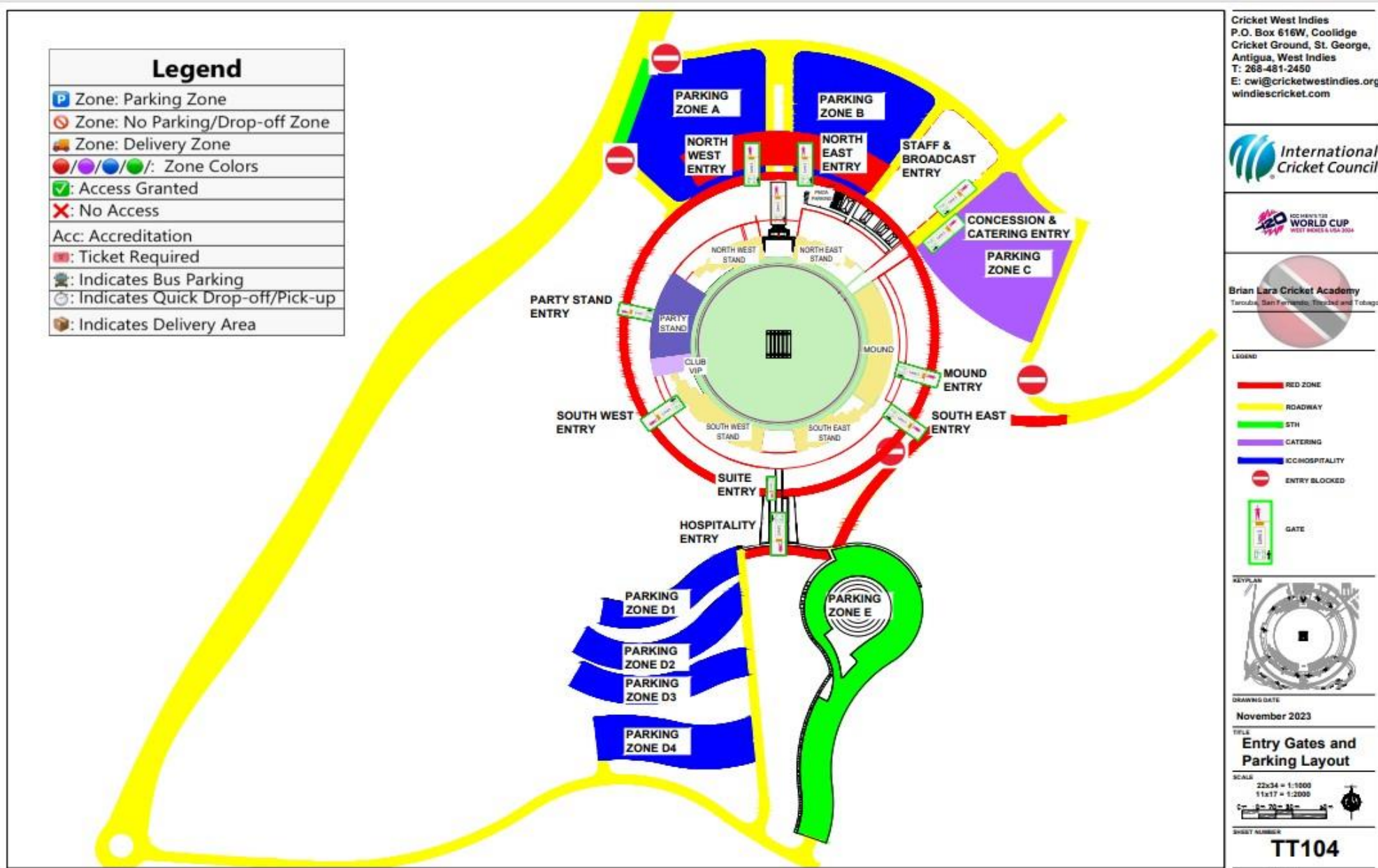
Mission Analysis – Venue Layout

- 12 outdoor practice pitches – 9 grassed pitches and 3 concrete/artificial turf
- LED Score Board
- Officials and Team Locker Rooms
- Gymnasium
- Facilities and Operational Equipment
- 20 Concession Booths
- 4 Novelties Booths
- Two Car Parks located to the North and South with a capacity to accommodate approximately **3,000 cars**.

Concept of Operations – Venue Management



The Venue has been divided and designated as specific 'Areas', for effective management and deployment of resources. These areas would be further sub-divide into Sectors.

- **Area 1:-** This is the Cricket Academy and its entrances.
- Sector 1- VIP Stands Inclusive Members Stands and Southern side covered stands inclusive of Concessionaire. ○ Sector 2- Party Stand and uncovered stands right and left of party stand (Western Side)
- Sector 3- Media Centre, Main entrance, Players Changing rooms, and Northern side [covered stands] inclusive of Concessionaire.
- Sector 4- Display Screen and uncovered areas right and left of the display screen (Eastern Side)

- **Area 2:-** This is the immediate external surrounding of the Brian Lara Cricket Academy to the fences and gates leading into the Venue. ○ Sector 1- The VIP car parks.
- Sector 2-The Staff car parks. [Parking would not be allowed for members of the public at BLCA-Park and Ride System to be Implemented.
- Sector 3- PMO Area and Team Access/Parking. ○ Sector 4-The main access road leading to the venue and roadway within the venue

- **Area 3:-** This is the external infrastructure outside of the Venue Area. ○ All access routes (Highway and roads) surrounding the venue

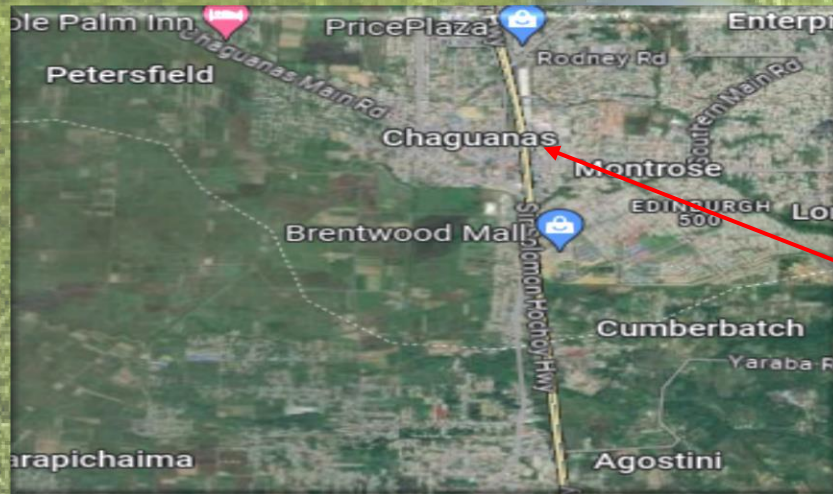

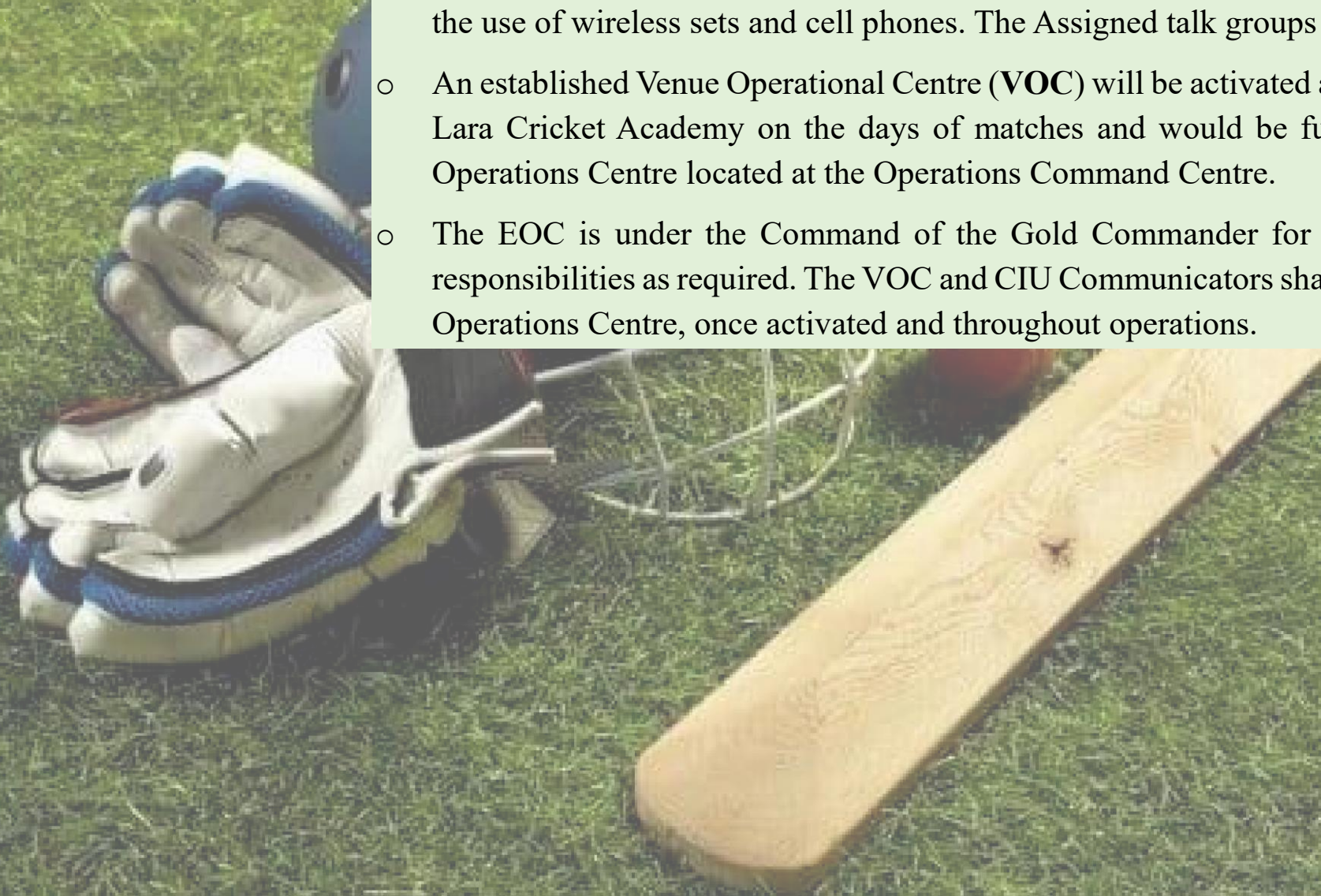

Communication

- During this event a communication plan will be established, managed by CIU who would utilize the use of wireless sets and cell phones. The Assigned talk groups for this event are **1C** and **5B**.
- An established Venue Operational Centre (**VOC**) will be activated at ALL Venues and at the Brian Lara Cricket Academy on the days of matches and would be further supported by the Event Operations Centre located at the Operations Command Centre.
- The EOC is under the Command of the Gold Commander for the event, who may delegate responsibilities as required. The VOC and CIU Communicators shall communicate with the Event Operations Centre, once activated and throughout operations.





Resource Management

Based on the nature of the event, considering the potential risks associated with events of this magnitude, the type of resources which would be required and deployed to provide the level of safety and security necessary and also to mitigate against any potential Threats are as follows: -

- Peace Officers (TTPS Officers)
- Specialized Security Sweeps (TTPS Special Branch / Bomb Detection Unit)
- Traffic Personnel (Southern Division/ Traffic and Highway Patrol Branch)
- Crowd Management Personnel (Guard and Emergency Branch/ Public Order Team – East Carpark)
- Crime Detection Personnel (Southern Division CID/ Southern Division Task Force)
- CCTV Surveillance (OCC, Southern Division Operations Centre, Mobile Units and Air surveillance)

Peace Officers

- TTPS; Southern Division will be providing Peace Officers who would be required to manage Areas 1 and Area 2.
- These officers would be placed at strategic locations and would be supported by the authorised private security provider. [TTPS - No Heavy Arms permitted inside the Venue]
- In Areas 1 and 2, they would perform point duties at strategic locations in and around the venue.





Peace Officers [Continued]

- They are required to do surveillance in an effort to deter and apprehend those committing criminal acts.
- In the event of an emergency or incident, they are required to provide support to the TTFS and Venue Facility Management, in the evacuation of all persons from the venue to both Muster Locations identified.

TTPS Special Branch / Explosive Detection & Disposal Unit)

- On match days and prior to opening the venue, members of the Explosive Detection and Disposal Unit (EDDU) will commence their specialized security sweep for (IED's) at the venue (Area 1 and Area 2).
- On completion of this exercise the EDDU will hand over the facility to the VOC Manager (TTPS).
- After the handover is complete and if any further intel on threats warrants this action, members of the EDDU would be on standby, for the duration of the match.
- The TTPS Special Branch, VVIP Protection Team will be responsible for the safety and security of the Prime Minister, Members of the Cabinet and other VVIP's attending.



Traffic Management

- Southern Division/ Traffic and Highway Patrol Officers will be required to implement the traffic restrictions around the venue in (Area 3).
- These officers would be placed at strategic locations, prior to the gates being officially opened to the public.
- Southern Division/ Traffic and Highway Patrol Officers will be required to perform duties (patrols) and manage the traffic around the venue [Ingress & Egress].
- Southern Division/ Traffic and Highway Patrol Officers will be required to identify emergency routes, ingress route and egress route, which will be monitored prior to, for the duration and until completion of the event and crowd dispersed.
- In the event of an incident requiring evacuation, Southern Division/ Traffic and Highway Patrol Officers will be required to assist in the safe evacuation of patrons from the venue to the designated Muster Points.



E.O.C and CCTV Surveillance Team

- The Event Operations Centre/ TTPS OCC personnel will be operating from within their units and would be providing visual coverage of the venue and surrounding areas for the duration of all matches.
- All routes to and from all venues [Hotels and Game/Practice Venues] would be monitored via the National CCTV Grid, through the Event Operations Centre.
- The TTPS Air Support Unit personnel would provide aerial surveillance of the venue and surrounding areas.
- The EOC will maintain communications with all critical National Security and Safety Stakeholders and the National Ops Centre, activating response seamlessly if the situation necessitates.
