4. Access to virtual meeting:

Kindly note that access will only be given to delegates who have duly registered in accordance with point 3 of this Bulletin.

5. KUDO connection links:

9. Connectivity and recommendations:

Please consider the following recommendations to facilitate access to the virtual platform:

- Connect via Google Chrome or Firefox, preferably from a desktop computer or a laptop.
- Verify \ that the domains kudoway.com and live.kudoway.com are added in the "whitelist" of the firewall and the mail server.
- Disconnect from any VPN.
- Download the KUDO application (app) and keep your device charged, if you wish to connect via a mobile device.

For a satisfactory experience in your virtual connection, it is suggested to take into consideration the following specifications:

- Make sure you have a strong internet connection with a minimum download/upload speed of 10/10 mb/s is required. Please test your connection to find out what bandwidth you have.
- Make sure to have a working webcam (internal or external).
- Make sure to connect using a good headset with a microphone, or headphones and a professional directional external microphone to avoid picking up ambient noise, and to ensure clear communication and interpretation.
- Preferably be in a private and quiet room with no background noise.
- Have good lighting.
- Test your connection and equipment prior to the meeting. You can attend the test sessions that will be carried out.

- Ensure no software or other applications are running on your computer that may be using the camera or microphone.
- Leave open only the applications you will use in the meeting.
