The information contained in this report is provided pursuant to resolution CP/RES. 759 (1217/99), "Guidelines for the Participation of Civil Society Organizations in OAS Activities." This document includes a summary and list of data and documentation presented by *Conectas* in accordance with the aforementioned Guidelines.

#### 1. Background

Conectas Direitos Humanos (Conectas) is a non-profit organization, established on September 11, 2001 in São Paulo, Brazil, that works on the defense of democracy and the democratic rule of law. The organization works to influence key actors, decision-makers, and those responsible for ensuring and protecting human rights and promoting justice. It also fights for greater civil society participation in areas that affect the population. Conectas acts through an extensive network of partners to prevent regression, report violations, and propose solutions. Its mission is to implement and expand human rights and fight inequality, in order to build a just, free, democratic society, from a Global South perspective.

Conectas aims to integrate and strengthen human rights by adopting a Global South perspective. Conectas draws on international and regional cooperation and human rights mechanisms and carries out solidarity actions to support partners in other regions.

Conectas obtains funding through donations, voluntary contributions, and other contributions.

Conectas submitted its application to the OAS on October 12, 2022.

#### 3. Primary areas of activity and contributions that could be of interest to the OAS

Conectas works to promote and defend human rights. The organization works to influence key actors and decision-makers to ensure and protect rights and to promote justice and greater civil society participation in decision-making on civil rights affecting the community. Conectas carries out advocacy work at the national and international levels, focusing on decision-making bodies and demanding government responses; the team also documents human rights violations, judicial litigation, and extrajudicial cases.
