1. Background

Padre Arrupe Foundation was established in El Salvador on May 6, 1994 as a non-profit organization, with a mission to deliver comprehensive, quality education, taking into account the socio-affective and economic characteristics of vulnerable segments of the Salvadoran population.

The Foundation's objective is to help students develop competencies, skills, and work techniques, as well as to nurture artistic sensibilities and foster creativity and mutual respect.

Its main area of operation is the development of cultural and scientific activities, especially those in the field of education that are intended to provide professional education and training, as well as to promote communication and dissemination of Catholic-inspired Latin American culture and science.

Padre Arrupe Foundation derives income from contributions made by its founding members, as well as from all kinds of donations, bequests to the Foundation, and income from properties it owns and acquires.

The Foundation applied for registration with the OAS on May 23, 2022.
