The IASPN was launched in 2009 by the OAS during a high-level event in New York as a regional network aimed at connecting Ministries of Social Development and other government agencies, international agencies, NGOs, the private sector, and academia to share information, exchange experiences, and transfer or adapt successful policies, programs, and practices to combat poverty and reduce inequality.


